

MOVEMENT OF CAMP IDPs






CAMP DEPARTURES



Between August 15 and October 22 2019, DTM tracked 16,636 households who left camps for non-camp settings.

These departures have occurred mainly in Ninewa and Salah Al-Din with a few in Anbar. As of now, most of the departures occurred from Airstrip, followed by Hamam Al-Alil 1 and Jeddah 6, which are now closed. In Ninewa, as mentioned, Airstrip and Hamam Al-Alil 1 are closed, and so are Salamyiah Nimrud, Jeddah 6, 4, 3 and 2. In Salah Al-Din, Al-Bsateen camp has been closed, and so are Al Qadisya and Al-Alam camps.





CAMP TO CAMP MOVEMENTS



During the reporting period, 3,674 households have moved between camps. Most of the movements have happened from camps that are being consolidated, most notably from Hamam Al-Alil 1 to 2, and from Airstrip to the other Jeddahs.

ARRIVALS OF IDPs FROM CAMPS TO NON-CAMP SETTINGS



A total of 9,883 households having displaced/returned to non-camp locations have been recorded in the same reporting period. The district hosting the highest number of tracked camp IDPs is Hatra,

followed by Baaj. Mosul and Sinjar also have received a high share of IDPs, while Telefar figures appear to stagnate. In addition to Ninewa, IDPs were also recorded in the governorates of Anbar, Erbil, Salah Al-Din and Kirkuk. It is important to note that not all households who have been recorded in these non-camp settings have returned to their areas of origin, and many of the IDPs who left camps are now non-camp IDPs.
